Summary:

The Early Impact Preschool Discoveries Classroom Aide will be responsible for caring for and supporting the early education of the children enrolled in Preschool Discoveries class. Aides will work with the classroom teacher to organize and support classroom activities to provide a safe, quality, and enjoyable learning environment for UIF's preschool students.

Responsibilities:

- Supporting in the design & implementation of lesson plans
- Helping with dismissal
- Prepping supplies for lessons
- Aiding in gross motor activities
- Help with developmental assessments
- Distributing snacks to children
- Make sure that each child is being well cared for during the day by performing a variety of tasks such
 as diapering/toileting, feeding, playing, etc.
- Clean classroom spaces daily
- Maintaining open communication with program manager, co-teachers and parents
- Provide spiritual development for the children through Bible stories and songs
- Assist in editing lesson plans and tracking data for assessments

Required Skills and Experience:

- Experience working with young children
- Strong oral and written communication skills
- Strong organizational skills
- Detail oriented
- Ability to work well in a non-structured environment
- Flexible and adaptable in a rapidly changing environment
- Ability to communicate with all levels of personnel and volunteers
