Who We Are:

Urban Impact is a Christian community development nonprofit ministry that desires to see lives holistically transformed in the North Side community one person, one family, and one block at a time who, in turn,make a powerful impact locally and globally for Jesus Christ. Our mission is to do our part in fulfilling Christ's Great Commission on the North Side of Pittsburgh by following His model of holistic ministry by investing in the lives of at-risk children, youth, and their families to develop mature, responsible followers of Jesus Christ. Summary:

The Performing Arts Department is about redeeming the arts for Christ and developing artists who love God through the art they produce. The Urban Missionary who takes this position must understand that Jesus is the first creative one, and we create out of the ability He gave us. The Performing Arts Department does this by running classes to train in art disciplines and bringing all disciplines together to produce largescale productions twice a year.

The Visual Arts Urban Missionary will coordinate, oversee, and cast vision for the visual arts discipline and help to facilitate the artistic design and painting of all scenery for the large-scale productions.

Responsibilities:

- Oversee visual arts classes in the Performing Arts Academy
- Develop the visual arts discipline and teach urban youth
- Facilitate the artistic design and painting of all scenery for the winter and summer annual productions
- Collaborate with staff and volunteers; communicate with students and parents
- Program administrative tasks including but not limited to tracking attendance, communication via email, and picking up supplies
- Carry out the spiritual mission of Urban Impact
- Lead Bible studies with students and mentor in spiritual maturity

Required Education, Skills and Experience:

- Undergraduate degree in art education, art, scenic design, scenic painting, or similar degree, and/or
- 3-year professional experience as art educator, artistic painter, scenic painter, or similar position
