The Senior Director of Athletics encompasses all three in addition to leading a dynamic team dedicated to ministry through sports.

Responsibilities:

- Develop strategic planning, cast vision, and provide leadership to the Athletics department
- Oversee the work of Athletics program managers, providing feedback and professional development as needed
- Recruit, train and equip Athletics staff, volunteers and students in order to transform lives and develop leaders who are able to give back to the community
- Seek the Lord's direction for the needs of the community. Determine the Lord's purpose and goals for each athletic program.
- Ensure department staff have the needed resources in place to carry out the plan (facilities, food, etc.).
- Equip program leaders to be disciple makers of students, parents, and volunteers
- Develop, oversee, and control the departmental budget
- Develop the strategic plan for the department
- Manage, develop, and hold staff accountable to fulfill their job requirements and annually create an individual development plan for each person on the athletics staff
- Equip Athletics staff and volunteers to give testimonies, lead Bible studies and to preach the word of God in program
- Meet with potential and existing networks, collaborations and partnerships (schools, churches,

businesses and community leaders) to establish new and maintain ongoing relationships

Required Education, Skills and Experience:

- College or seminary degree or equivalent experience
- 5+ years ministry experience required, preferable in urban ministry
- 3+ years management and leadership experience
- Proven ability to develop and implement strategies that align with organizational goals
- Experience in managing department budgets and driving productivity
- Experience in roles developing individuals and teams, strategic decision making, building partnerships, and facilitating change

Clearances Required:

National and state background clearances will be required.

Organizational Requirements:

- Driver's license and clear driving record
- Three-year commitment
- This is a missionary support-raised position that is required to raise funds to cover its salary and must be willing to move to the North Side of Pittsburgh within a reasonable period of time after hire.
- Urban Impact employees are expected to align with the organization's faith-based mission and be a living example of the mission of Jesus. At Urban Impact Foundation, we don't just want our staff to be highly qualified in their professional skills. Since ministry is a holy calling, our staff must be believers in and committed followers of Jesus Christ, morally sound, and committed to the vision of Urban Impact. Physical Demands:

- This position functions in a normal office environment that requires the ability to successfully interface with standard office equipment such as computers, printers, copiers, fax, telephones, etc.
- Medium work that includes moving objects up to 50 pounds
- Travel to local schools and venues for programs and meetings and move about various school buildings, athletic fields, and other facilities
- Works in outdoor weather conditions
- Frequently moving about in an athletic environment indoors or on outdoor fields or uneven terrain
- Frequently requiring physical ability to work around small children
