Our mission is to do our part in fulfilling Christ's Great Commission on the North Side of Pittsburgh by following His model of holistic ministry by investing in the lives of at-risk children, youth, and their families to develop mature, responsible followers of Jesus Christ. Position Summary:

The Soccer Urban Missionary will engage children and youth in the community through a soccer program while focusing on sharing the gospel of Jesus through evangelism and empowering others to reach the lost for Jesus. The Urban Missionary will also recruit, train and motivate volunteers to engage in diverse, cross-cultural ministry in Pittsburgh's North Side.


Ideal candidates must be committed to communicating and demonstrating the good news of Jesus Christ while helping at-risk children, youth, and families grow holistically. The Urban Missionary should have the ability to manage others through training, coaching and delegating leadership responsibility through multiple soccer sites in various neighborhoods in the city.

Responsibilities:

- Carry out the spiritual mission of Urban Impact
- Conduct Bible studies with UIF students
- Provide vision for the soccer program and write yearly strategic plan
- Schedule and plan out the season for the various age groups of the teams
- Volunteer recruiting, mentoring and care
- Disciple children, youth and their families
- Assist in office administration

Required Education, Skills and Experience:

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent experience
- Comprehensive understanding of the gospel and its core tenants
- Ability to work well in a non-structured, youth-oriented environment

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Preferred Education, Skills and Experience:

- Biblical training
- Athletics background, soccer preferred

Travel required

- Local travel to soccer fields, schools, trainings, programs, and events is required
- Use of personal vehicle is required with mileage reimbursement

Clearances Required:

National and state background clearances will be required.

Organizational Requirements:

- Three-year commitment
- Driver's license and clear driving record
- This is a support-raised position that is required to raise funds to cover its salary and must be willing to move to the North Side of Pittsburgh within a reasonable period of time after hire.
- Urban Impact employees are expected to align with the organization's faith-based mission and be a living example of the mission of Jesus.
